

Purpose

Participants will engage while learning current research-based practices in pediatric and school nursing through interactive teaching and learning strategies. Participants will also recognize how the practice of school nursing inspires and influences the health of all individuals in the school setting.

Objectives

- Distinguish health related factors putting pediatric oncology students at risk in the school setting.

- Differentiate life threatening and non-life threatening student chest pain and appropriate interventions for each type of pain.
- Apply the 21st Century School Health Framework to the practice of school nursing in Iowa.

- Differentiate oral health challenges for special needs vs. non-special needs students and oral health resources for all students.
- Develop school base team to manage academic & activity expectations for students after a head injury.

- Identify NAMI mental health resources available for school staff, family members, and students.
- Select appropriate interventions to manage burns in pediatric populations.
